#### **COMMITTEES**

### **Executive Board**

Meeting was held on 1/26/17 and attended by Chairman Scarlato and Commissioner Bommer. New agenda for the meetings was distributed by Chief Lewis. The Fire Bureau's fire safety trailer was discussed. Should it be replaced or refurbished? The Board discussed possible purchasing a new on by the Board and renting it back to the township. After a discussion, it was decided not to move forward with either option. The T-1 lines have all been upgraded. The next meeting will be on 3/23/17.

### Chief's Report

All reports were submitted by the chief. The Chief reported that there are issues with the turnout gear that the cadets are wearing at the fire academy. The cadets are being told by the instructor that the gear is not appropriate and out of compliance. The Chief is suggesting to possibly purchase new gear for the cadets prior to their entry into their fire fighter I class.

It was noted that Cadet Lou Gallo was at the fire academy on Sunday (2/12/17) and was transported to JSUMC due to trouble breathing. Chairman Scarlato and Captain Romano accompanied cadet Gallo to the hospital. The proper insurance paperwork has been completed by Clerk Acampora pertaining to workers compensation. Cadet Gallo will need to provide a letter from a doctor clearing him to continue his training. The Chief also stated that he is hearing reports from cadets currently in the fire academy that there is excessive physical fitness being enforced as punishment for teams not completing their training properly.

Chief Eadicicco reported that at the last township chief's meeting the Red Alert system was discussed. Station 19-3 is taking the lead on handling all issues related to Red Alert. They will be working on obtaining one (1) township wide maintenance agreement.

The SCBA bottles that were ordered have been received. All hose has been received. The portable radio bank chargers have been ordered, along with the portable radios. It was noted that the expired SCBA bottles may be able to be sold on E-Gov.com.

Chief Eadicicco also stated that he does not have any more helmet shields. Chairman Scarlato stated that there are six (6) shields in the commissioner's office that he will give to him.

### **Chief Engineer**

The brakes on Brush 494 have been serviced and all issues have been addressed.

Chief Engineer Gilsenan requested that he receive copies of all maintenance bills so he can keep a log of work has been completed on what vehicles.

The oxygen fill station donated to the fire company from Brick Township will be delivered in the near future, whenever we can coordinate the delivery with Brick Township.

Ongoing issues with Engine 480 – the brakes have been repaired and a new Hannay Reel has been installed in the front bumper in order for the Holmatro tool system to work properly. Due to limited space, the electric reel was lost, but the junction box and extension cord will still remain in the front bumper.

### **Purchaser**

It was noted that we still have a computer systems bill outstanding from October 2016. Chief Eadicicco is requesting that we pay this bill for the equipment that was received, but it has not been installed yet.

Chief Eadicicco stated that he would like to purchase tow (2) new chief's helmets – one for himself and one for 2nd Assistant Chief Gotto.

The Chief also noted that he needs additional forms for home owners to sign for carbon monoxide calls and refusal of medical assistance (RMA) calls.

Need to fit two (2) cadets that are currently in the fire academy for new gear.

The Chief stated that his Class A uniform jacket and pants are severely worn and need replacement.

The printer in the Chief's office is broken and will cost \$114 to repair – new printer heads. It was discussed that would mostly likely to be cheaper to purchase a new printer instead of fixing the old one.

Chairman Scarlato noted that the fire board elections will be taking place on Saturday, February 18, 2017 from 2pm – 9pm. He stated that Commissioner Bailey is running unopposed for a 3 year and he requested all come out to approve the 2017 budget.
