#### Chief's Report

All reports were submitted by Chief Eadicicco.

The Chief stated that he is still having problems with the Red Alert program and he has not been receiving much assistance from them towards correcting the issues. He suggested that no further payments be made until all issues have been resolved.

Station shorts have been ordered for all fire fighters based on the sizes that were taken for the station pants.

Turnout gear and ropes have been ordered.

### **Chief Engineer**

The damaged bumper on Engine 480 will be fixed by Defender Emergency Equipment. The battery switches on 486 need to be replaced.

### Purchaser

The Chief stated that the radio in Engine 480 is still having issues. He will contact the technician from Allcom Technologies to see if they can come out and take a look at the radio.

The battery for Captain Romano's radio has been ordered and will be in within a week. Firefighting helmets have been received.

The Chief will be sizing all fire fighters in order to place the order the extrication gloves. Additional EMS bags need to be ordered.

The portable radios have been received and the charging banks need to be installed in the apparatus.

Two (2) additional black firefighting helmets need to be ordered (\$361.60 each) The Chief has scheduled a training class at the Middlesex Fire Academy and it will cost \$900. He is also requesting \$400 for material to build additional training props.

A motion was made by Commissioner Stalling and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to approve the \$900 for the Middlesex Fire Academy and \$723.30 for two (2) firefighting helmets. Motion passed unanimously by the Board. Additional discussing will be held pertaining to the material for the training props.

Prices will be obtained by the Chief Engineer for the proper installing and testing of the new Oxygen fill station received from Brick Twp.

Holmatro service has been performed on all extrication tools and all equipment has been certified, including the reel in the bumper on Engine 480.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

One of the repeaters and radio equipment was recently damaged at police headquarters causing Howell Fire 2 to be out of service. It is believed that the damage was caused by a lightning strike from a recent storm. The damage has been estimated at \$15,000.00. The fire bureau has filed an insurance claim via the town, as the equipment is located at a township owned facility. We are awaiting the outcome of the claim.

A motion was made by Commissioner Stalling and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to approve the LOSAP distribution request from fire fighter Jerome. Clerk Acampora has reviewed the request and stated that fire fighter Jerome meets the criteria in order to withdraw his funds. The motion passed unanimously by the Board.
