Chief's Report

All reports were turned in by Assistant Chief Gotto.

Assistant Chief Gotto discussed the SOGs that were submitted to the Board for review pertaining to the administration of NARCAN. A motion was made by Commissioner Bommer and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to approve the NARCAN SOGs as submitted. Motion passed unanimously by the Board. Chairman Scarlato stated that he would contact Peggy Doyle at Howell Township in order to obtain a letter from the town stating that the fire company will be under the supervision of the towns Medical Director pertaining to training and administration of the NARCAN product. We will not be able to move forward with program until the letter is obtained and proper training has been administered.

The new SCBAs have been ordered. Several lettering designs were discussed for the bottles and packs. It was determined that the bottles will have the company patch under a clear coat finish and the pack number will be placed on the band of the pack that holds the bottle.

Firefighters Smigelsky and Major's equipment have been received in full. A pulse Ox meter was not ordered, as a new one was located in the medical closet.

Pump operations class requested via All Hands is no longer needed, as members have been able to register for the pump ops classes being provided at the Monmouth County Fire Academy.

Assistant Chief Gotto requested permission to bring the following vehicles to Wildwood: 467, 487, and 488. A motion was made by Commissioner Bommer and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to the allow vehicles 467, 487, and 488 to be taken to Wildwood. The motion passed unanimously by the Board.

Chairman Scarlato stated that Ladder 490 is going to be sent to Fire and Safety Services on 10/22/18 for annual maintenance and UL testing on the ladder. While at Fire and Safety, they will perform a full inspection of the apparatus and inform the Board of any items that need to be addressed.

The incident command box in vehicle 487 has been removed. A motion was made by Commissioner Bommer and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to dispose of the outdated incident command box. Motion passed unanimously by the Board.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bommer and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to have vehicle 466 serviced for an oil change and tire rotation at Pine Belt Chevy. Motion passed unanimously by the Board.

The fluids in vehicles 487, 488, and 467 have been changed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bommer and seconded Commissioner Bailer to let fire fighters take vehicle 488 to MA for the NJ Natural Gas training. Motion passed unanimously by the Board.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bommer and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to have 4 new tires installed on vehicle 466. Motion passed unanimously by the Board.

Purchaser

Commissioner Bailey stated that the hand tools (\$850) and the search/rescue bag (\$650) that were approved for purchase at the previous month's meeting will look to be purchased in Wildwood.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bommer and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to purchase one (1) Vent saw, one (1) K-12 saw, and saw blades and bracket mounts. These items were included in the 2018. Motion passed unanimously by the Board.
