### **Executive Board**

Voucher sent to Motorola for \$38,010.74 for repairs to repeater. Will authorize payment for the voucher when the work has been completed.

### Chief's Report

All reports were submitted by the Chief.

Portable radio from Engine 480 has been sent back to ALLCOM as it is not working correctly.

Vehicle 467 has never been detailed and it needs to be.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bommer and seconded by Commissioner Stalling to have vehicle 467 detailed for a maximum price of \$200. The motion passed unanimously by the Board.

The fire company is in the process of creating a RIT team and having all RIT team members qualified as per the County guidelines.

A draft of the department RIT guidelines has been submitted to the Board for review. The Board will check with their insurance carrier to verify that we are covered for this type of operation, but the Board did not foresee any issues.

### **Chief Engineer**

Engine 475 – Batteries have been replaced

Ladder 490 – The Pre-set still needs to be serviced, along with the steering

Tanker 495 – There is an air leak in the truck. Will have service technician try to find out the cause. Will also be obtaining a quote for the installation of Auto-Air eject for this truck.

Brush 494 – Muffle has been replaced on the pump

Utility 486 – all issued have presently been fixed

Engine 480 – tire issues were due to a broken valve stem, which has been replaced

A motion was made by Commissioner Bommer and seconded by Commissioner Stalling to move forward with the installation of the receivers at a cost of \$2,462. Motion passed unanimously by the Board.

Chief is requesting the purchase of a 5-way valve to be used with the Monmouth County pipeline. Cost of the value is \$1,600.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bommer and seconded by Commissioner Stalling to purchase the 5-way valve at a cost not to exceed \$1,600. Motion passed unanimously by the Board.

The chief is requesting \$3,000 for training in order for 15 fire fighters to attend RIT OPS training. This class is currently not offered at the Monmouth County Fire Academy, so we have to seek training elsewhere.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bommer and seconded by Commissioner Stalling to approve \$3,000 for 15 fire fighters to attend RIT OPS training. Motion passed unanimously by the Board.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Chairman Scarlato reminded the line officers that they should be compiling the information requested for the ISO audit. Chief Connolly stated they have tied up on the SCBA project and will continue to obtain the information requested and will coordinate with the Clerk of the Board. Chairman Scarlato stated that Howell Township is requesting a meeting with the Board to discuss connection the hydrants at Soldier Memorial Park to the new water line being installed on Route 547. Chairman Scarlato and Clerk Acampora will meet with Chief Lewis and James Herrman from the township to discuss and will report back to the Board.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

SCBA presentation given by Chief Connolly and his line officers. MSA is the company and product that is recommended by the Line Officers. The Board discussed with the Line Officers the results of the testing perform by the Line Officers and fire fighters between MSA and SCOTT. The Line Officers would like to move forward with MSA as our vendor. They would like to bring in a salesman and have him look at our apparatus to determine what we would need in order to mount the new breathing units. The Chief noted that if the units are purchased before 6/30/18, MSA will upgrade the units free of charge when the new changes come out in late 2018. Chairman Scarlato noted that the Board had no problem moving forward with MSA to come to the fire house, but we will also have to allow SCOTT the same opportunity.

On a motion by Commissioner Bommer and seconded by Commissioner Stalling, to approve to move forward with investigating MSA as the vendor to purchase the new breathing apparatus from. We will also allow SCOTT the same opportunity. Motion passed unanimously by the Board.

A committee will be formed to meet with the vendors consisting of Chairman Scarlato, Commissioner Stalling, and whom ever the Chief would like to attend from his Line Officers.
