

RESOLUTION EXTENDING CONTRACT FOR PREVENTIVE  
MAINTENANCE/REPAIR TO FIRE APPARATUS AND VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 4, Township of Howell, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, entered into a Contract for Preventive Maintenance/Repair to Fire Apparatus and Vehicles with Defender Emergency Products Sales & Service, 126 S. Main Street, Farmingdale, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the term of the Contract for Preventive Maintenance/Repair to Fire Apparatus and Vehicles terminated on March 8, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Contract for Preventive Maintenance/Repair to Fire Apparatus and Vehicles provided that the Board may extend the Contract for an additional one (1) ~~or two (2)~~ year under the same terms and conditions as set forth in the original Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Board has elected to extend the Contract for Preventive Maintenance/Repair to Fire Apparatus and Vehicles through March 8, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds and determines that the extension of the Contract for Preventive Maintenance/Repair to Fire Apparatus and Vehicles is in the best interest of the township and the taxpayers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 4, Township of Howell, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that it extend the Contract for Preventive Maintenance/Repair to Fire Apparatus and Vehicles through March 8, 2023, under the same terms and conditions as set forth in the original Contract; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board Chairman be authorized to execute any and all documents to effectuate the intent and purpose of the within Resolution and the Clerk attest thereto; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the within Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resolution or part of a resolution inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or otherwise revoked; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Resolution is for any reason held or determined to be unconstitutional or invalid, same shall not affect the remainder of this Resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notwithstanding anything set forth herein to the contrary, the Board shall be permitted to amend, modify, repeal or otherwise act as to those topics which are the subject of this Resolution provided said acts are consistent with public policy, Board bylaws, township ordinances, local, state and federal laws and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an original signed, conformed and compared copy of this Resolution be accessible and maintained as an official Board record pursuant to and in accordance with the "Open Public Records Act"; N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1, *et seq.* and the "Destruction of Public Records Law (1953)"; N.J.S.A. 47:3-8.1, *et seq.* as set forth by the State of New Jersey Municipal Agency Record Retention Schedule promulgated by the Division of Archives and Record Management.
